

Resolution proposing a change to the rules of the Republican Conference for the 118th Congress

Offered by: Mrs. Cammack (FL-03)

Sec. 1. For the purpose of the election of Republican Leadership positions, Conference Rule 4(c) is amended by striking “a majority” and inserting “80%”.

It shall read as follows:

Balloting Procedures.—When there are more than two candidates for any office and none receives a majority of the votes on the first ballot, a quorum being present, the candidate with the lowest number of votes on that and each succeeding ballot will be dropped from the ballot until one candidate receives 80% of the votes, a quorum being present.

Sec. 2(a). For the purposes of passing Republican Conference Motions under Rule 6(b), Resolutions under Rule 6(c), and Petitions under Rule 6(d); these proceedings will only pass by an 80% threshold in the affirmative.

Sec. 2(b). Rule 6(e) is removed from the rules resolution.
